## USE OF COMMITTEES

### I. Board Committees

The Board may authorize the establishment of committees from among its membership as it finds necessary to study operations in specific areas and to make recommendations for Board action.

All committees will be appointed by the Board president. The superintendent and the Board president will serve as ex-officio members of all committees.

The functions of committees will ordinarily be fact-finding, deliberative, and advisory, and their reports will be made to the Board for discussion and action. All committee appointments will be for no longer than necessary to discharge the completion of their assignment.

### II. Advisory Committees

The Board will, when it deems appropriate, appoint advisory committees including both Board members and patrons to counsel and assist the District in planning programs and projects. Since a school board possesses certain legal powers and prerogatives which cannot be delegated or surrendered to others, all recommendations of advisory committees must be submitted to the Board for official action.

The Board will have the power to dissolve any advisory committee and will reserve the right to exercise this power at any time during the life of any committee.
