## MILITARY KID OF THE DAY: Ms. Murphy



1st Lieutenant Thomas Joseph Murphy served in the Air Force from 1958-1964 then enlisted in the Army. He entered Officer Candidate School and Jump School in late 1965. He became an Infantry Platoon Leader at Ft. Benning, GA. 1st Lieutenant Murphy was

deployed to Vietnam in Jan. 1967 in the 25th Infantry Wolfhounds. 1st Lieutenant Murphy died on March 21st, 1967 at the age of 26 in Cu Chi Vietnam. His wife, Gloria, was very proud of him and his children continue to be very proud of both Thomas and Gloria and their service to the United States.
