EDUCATIONAL ENRICHMENT

An educational enrichment fund in the amount of \$15,000 may be established annually to fund teacher-initiated projects which will benefit students directly or indirectly.

A maximum of \$5,000 will be available to each of three levels: K-4, 5-8, and 9-12. Proposals for use of the funds may be submitted by individual teachers, teachers in a building, teachers in a grade level, or teachers in an academic department.

Proposals must be submitted in writing to the superintendent no later than March 1 of the year prior to implementation. A form with specifications for the written proposals may be obtained from building principals.

A committee composed of the superintendent, the curriculum coordinator, and all the principals of the District shall review the proposals and recommend approval of selected proposals to the Board by April 1. Approval of proposals shall be determined by need and by overall benefits to students.

District staff will be informed by April 1 of any remaining funds. The committee will consider proposals for use of remaining funds until May 1 and will determine whether to recommend approval of such proposals by June 1.
