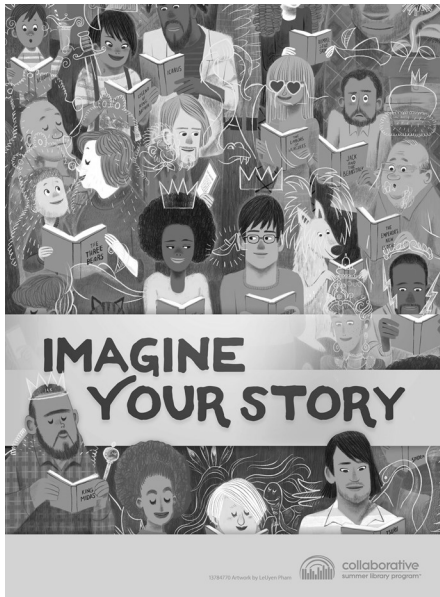
You can also share this link with friends and family and their purchases will also go toward free books for our school.
