Principal's Report

Unfinished Business

- Activity cart
 - Donations of \$200.00 from BarSto; \$50.00 from Whitewood Chiropractic; and, \$500.00 from the City of Sturgis
 - Donations have raised enough money to proceed with purchasing the activity cart, pending finding out the cost of shipping to ensure that amount is covered by the donations.
 - Hillary will order
 - The cart will include 93 pieces of equipment.

- Potato Feed
 - Raised \$592.00 in donations, not taking out expenses.
 - Hideaway made 100 potatoes. 15 left over.
 - Made 96 hot dogs. 15 left over
 - Made 40 cups of coffee
 - Made 4 gallons of lemonade
 - Used 4 corned beef roasts and 4 cabbages; almost all gone
 - Used 4 ½ buckets of ice cream
 - Used one full crock pot of chili, broccoli and cheese, and nacho cheese

- Some chili and some nacho cheese were left over
- Had some leftover toppings like sour cream, shredded cheese
- Discussed still using someone to clean after event. It was decided that would be discussed prior to each event in the future.
- Easter Egg Hunt
 - The event will be held on April 18 at 2:30 PM at Memorial Park.
 - Becky ordered prizes.
 - Bev indicated there were about 1100 plastic eggs to fill.
 - It was discussed as to whether more new eggs should be purchased. It was also discussed that if people have ones they would like to donate, that would be fine.
 - Bev had purchased a couple of bags of candy.
 - Hillary indicated that the WW 8-10 Club would donate \$25.00 and that there were a couple of other businesses in town that probably would also.
 - The group forgot to discuss the provision of ice cream treats for the students after the event but had agreed to do so at the February meeting.
