#### ADMINISTRATION IN POLICY ABSENCE

In the absence of Board policy specifically covering any action that the superintendent feels must be taken for the orderly execution of duties or orderly transaction of normal school business, the superintendent may take temporary action that he/she feels will be in harmony with the overall policy of the Board. However, the superintendent will not be free to act when the action involves a duty of the Board that by law cannot be delegated.

In each case in which the superintendent must take such action, he/she will discuss this action as soon as possible with the president of the Board and present the matter to the entire Board for its consideration at its next meeting. If the action may result in a strong reaction by students, staff, or patrons, the superintendent will inform all Board members as soon as possible.
