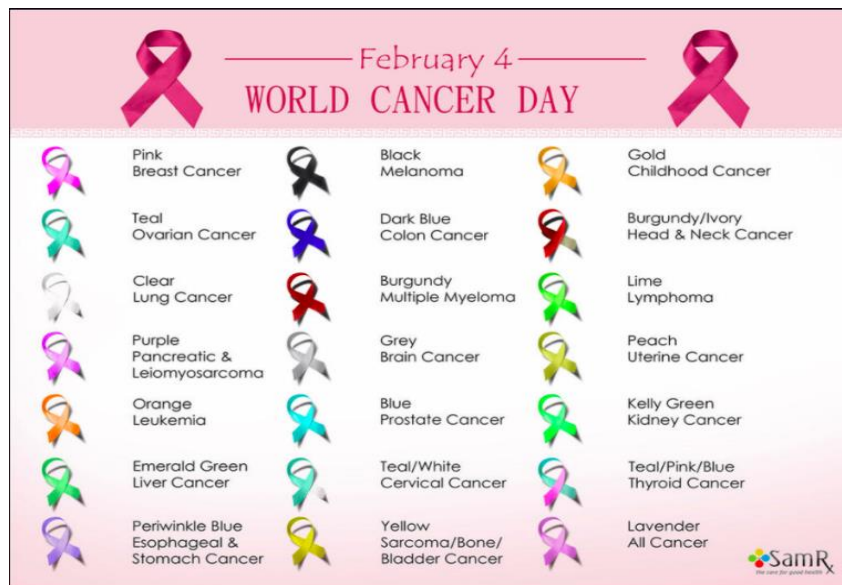
Currently, Mr. Skinner's class has all 6 pictures correct.
