Dear Parent or Guardian,

Sturgis Elementary has had multiple positive cases of Covid- 19 this week. To start next week, we will maintain Phase I (green) status. In the event of an increase in our numbers of Covid positive cases, we may move to Phase 2 (white) status where masks are **recommended** when social distancing isn't available. I will continue to communicate with as necessary regarding Covid 19 updates.

Symptoms of COVID-19 include:

Fever or chills · Difficulty breathing · Headache · Congestion or runny nose

Cough · Fatigue · Loss of taste or smell · Nausea or vomiting

Shortness of breath · Muscle or body aches · Sore throat · Diarrhea

Recommendations:

- 1. Be watchful for symptoms suggestive of COVID-19 illness
- 2. Take precautions to avoid illness, including:
- 3. Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- 4. Cover your mouth and nose with a cloth face cover when around others
- 5. Avoid close contact with people who are sick
- 6. Refrain from touching your eyes, nose, and mouth
- 7. Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue
- 8. Clean frequently touched surfaces and objects
- 9. Individuals at higher risk for severe COVID-19 illness, such as older adults or people who have chronic medical conditions like heart, lung, or kidney disease, should take actions to reduce your risk of exposure (https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/need-extra-precautions/people-with-medical-conditions.html)
