SUPERVISION OF STUDENTS

When students are in school, engaging in school-sponsored activities, or traveling to and from school on school buses or other school authorized vehicles, they are responsible to the school, and the school is responsible for them. Authorized school personnel assigned to their supervision serve *in loco parentis*.

The Board expects all students to be under assigned adult supervision at all times when they are in school, on school grounds during the school day, traveling under school auspices, or engaging in school-sponsored activities. School personnel assigned this supervision are expected to act prudently in providing for the safety of the students in their charge. Staff members will not leave groups unsupervised unless an arrangement has been made to take care of an emergency.

During school hours, or while engaging in school-sponsored activities, students will be released only to custodial parents, legal guardians, or other persons authorized by the parents and school.
