CONGRATULATIONS: The Sturgis Brown High School Speech and Debate team captured their fourth team trophy of the year, winning the "3A" division in Gillette at the Bolt Blast High School Speech and Debate Tournament. The meet featured 13 schools from South Dakota and Wyoming. These individual earned first place honors: Max Hinek in Lincoln Douglas Debate, Abby Johnson in Humor, Carlie Johnson in Original Oratory, Wyatt Trokimoinen in Student Congress, and Chris Shuman in Extemp. Sturgis Brown had numerous other place winners.

South Dakota Students Selected for United States Senate Youth Program Students to Participate in Online Program and to Receive \$10,000 Scholarship:

The United States Senate Youth Program (USSYP) announces that high school students Matea Joy Gordon and Grace Enz and will join Senator John Thune and Senator Michael Rounds in representing South Dakota during the 60th annual USSYP Washington Week. Matea Gordon of Whitewood and Grace Enz of Brookings were selected from among the state's top student leaders to be part of the 104 national student delegation who will each receive a \$10,000 college scholarship for undergraduate study.
