Please remember—Your child must be fever free for 24 hours without the aid of medication before returning to school.

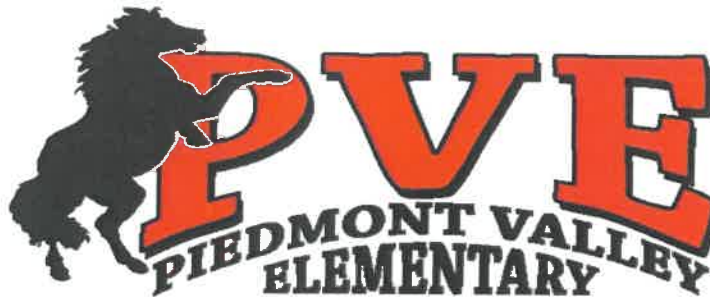

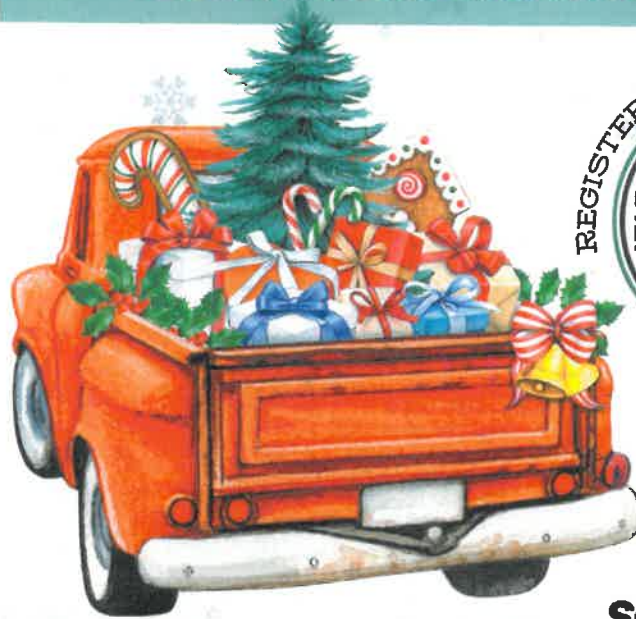
